Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
- **To vote for a write-in candidate:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of the blank line and write in the candidate's name. Only votes cast for candidates who filed as write-in candidates can be counted.
- Do not write in a candidate's name if that person's name already is printed on the ballot for that same contest.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (ADDITIONAL) MERCER COUNTY

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

An additional tax for the benefit of Mercer County for the purpose of operating or capital improvement expenditures necessary for the support of children's services and the care and placement of children for the Children's Services Division of the Mercer County Department of Job and Family Services at a rate not exceeding four-tenths (0.4) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to four cents (\$0.04) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for ten years, commencing in 2016, first due in calendar year 2017.

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL) MERCER COUNTY

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Mercer County for the purpose of developmental disabilities programs and services and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance, and operation of developmental disabilities facilities by the Board of Developmental Disabilities (a.k.a. Cheryl Ann Programs) at a rate not exceeding two and forty-two hundredths mills (2.42) for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 24.2 cents (\$0.242) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for six years, commencing in 2017, first due in calendar year 2018.
